Thomas Hampton, 1623 - 1690, (My 9th Great Grandfather – David Arthur) was the greatgreat-grandfather of Wade Hampton b. 1752 d. February 4, 1835), a South Carolina soldier, politician, two-term U.S. Congressman, and wealthy plantation owner. He was the scion of the politically important Hampton family, which was influential in state politics almost into the 20th century.

Wade Hampton served in the American Revolution as a Lieutenant Colonel in a South Carolina volunteer cavalry regiment. And was a Democratic-Republican member of Congress for South Carolina from 1795 to 1797 and from 1803 to 1805, and a presidential elector in 1801.
